All dogs and cats three months of age or older must be registered. The owner of a dog or cat who fails to register his/her animal may be liable to an on-the-spot fine for each unregistered animal. If a child under 17 has a dog or cat it must be registered in the parent's or guardian's name.

Changes to the Domestic Animals Act 1994 requires that an owner registering dog or cat for the first time will not be eligible for a reduced fee for animals that are microchipped alone. These changes do not affect animals currently registered and renewed annually. Council Domestic Animal management policy requires that all cats be desexed prior to registration.

Pensioners Holders of eligible pension cards are entitled to a reduction as listed in the fees for pensioners. Please present your card in person at the time of registration. Please note health care card holders are not entitled to reduced fees for pensioners.

Replacement Registration Tags Replacement registration tags can be obtained free of charge from any Customer Service Centre.

Documents For entitlement to reduced registration fees, proof of sterilisation, microchip implant, breeding license, statutory declaration or tax return for proof of working dog status is required.

Cat Confinement Cats must be contained from sunset to sunrise. Does your property comply with cat confinement requirements.

Excess Animal Permits Permits must be obtained to keep more than 2 dogs or more than 2 cats per residential premises.

Restricted Breeds The following restricted breeds must be declared:

1. American Pitbull Terrier Cross or Pitbull Terrier Cross
2. Dogo Argentino
3. Fila Brasileiro
4. Japanese Tosa
5. Perro de Presa Canario or Presa Canario

Penalties Owners of unregistered animals may receive on-the-spot fines for each animal. Registration checks will commence after 10 April.

Certificate of Registration Once your registration fee is paid this notice will be deemed to be your certificate of registration. Your current registration tag is not valid until payment is made.

Registration Refunds Registration refunds for deceased animals are available subject to Council Policy.
